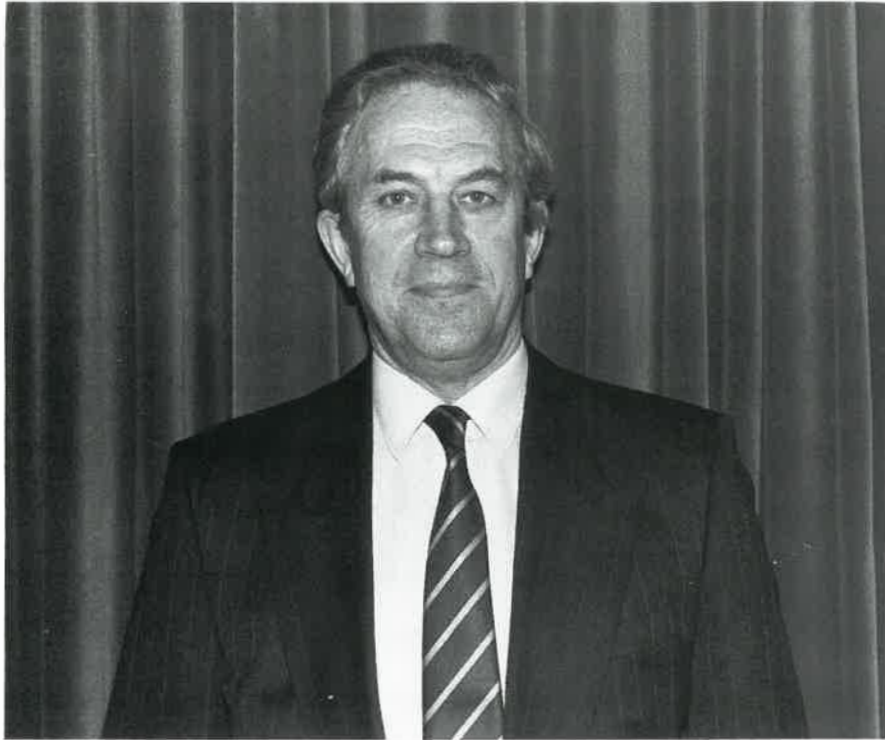

It is with great pleasure that I welcome you to the third British Lift Association Exhibition.

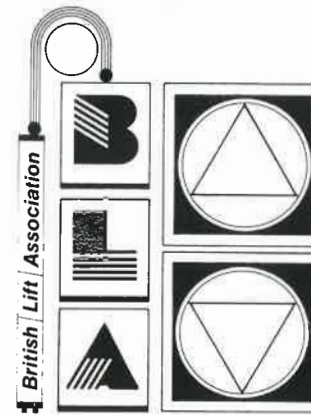
Since the first Exhibition in 1986, the Association has gone from strength to strength and now represents over eighty Member companies.

The objectives of the BLA are to stimulate cooperation in the handling of all matters in connection with the manufacture, installation, repair, and maintenance of lifts, escalators and other associated equipment in the UK.

Qualifications for Membership

Regular members must be employers of personnel directly connected with the manufacture installation, repair and maintenance of lifts, escalators or associated equipment in the UK. There are three classes of Regular Membership the basic qualifying requirements for which will be:

CONTRACTOR MEMBERSHIP. The Contractor Membership is composed of Companies and firms regularly and substantially engaged in the business of selling, installing and servicing vertical and horizontal handling and other equipment incident thereto (commonly known as passenger goods or service lifts, escalators, man-lifts, moving walks, etc).

SUPPLIER MEMBERSHIP. The Supplier Membership is composed of Companies or firms regularly and substantially engaged in what is known in the lift industry as supplying components, accessories or services for vertical and horizontal handling and other equipment incident thereto (commonly known as passenger, goods or service lifts, escalators, man-lifts, moving walks, etc).

DUAL CONTRACTOR—SUPPLIER MEMBERSHIP. Contractors who solicit or are regularly engaged in supplying components or accessories for vertical and horizontal equipment as described above, either in its own company name, a subsidiary, affiliate or a company in which it has an interest shall maintain a dual Contractor-Supplier membership in the name of such company or companies or apply for membership as a supplier.

Suppliers who solicit or are regularly engaged in selling, installing or servicing vertical horizontal handling equipment as described above, either in its own company name, a subsidiary, affiliate or a company in which it has an interest, may choose to maintain dual Contractor-Supplier Membership. Supplier firms holding a dual membership shall be permitted to hold office in a Supplier member status only.

In order to qualify, an applicant for Contractor or Supplier membership must meet the following requirements:

Must have been engaged in business as a Lift Contractor or Supplier, at least two years prior to the date on which application is made.

Must have an established place of business.

Must subscribe to the principles, and, wherever possible in practice, comply with current British Standards and Code of Practice for Lifts and Escalators, or other codes or ordinance having applicability.

Must have an acceptable credit rating.

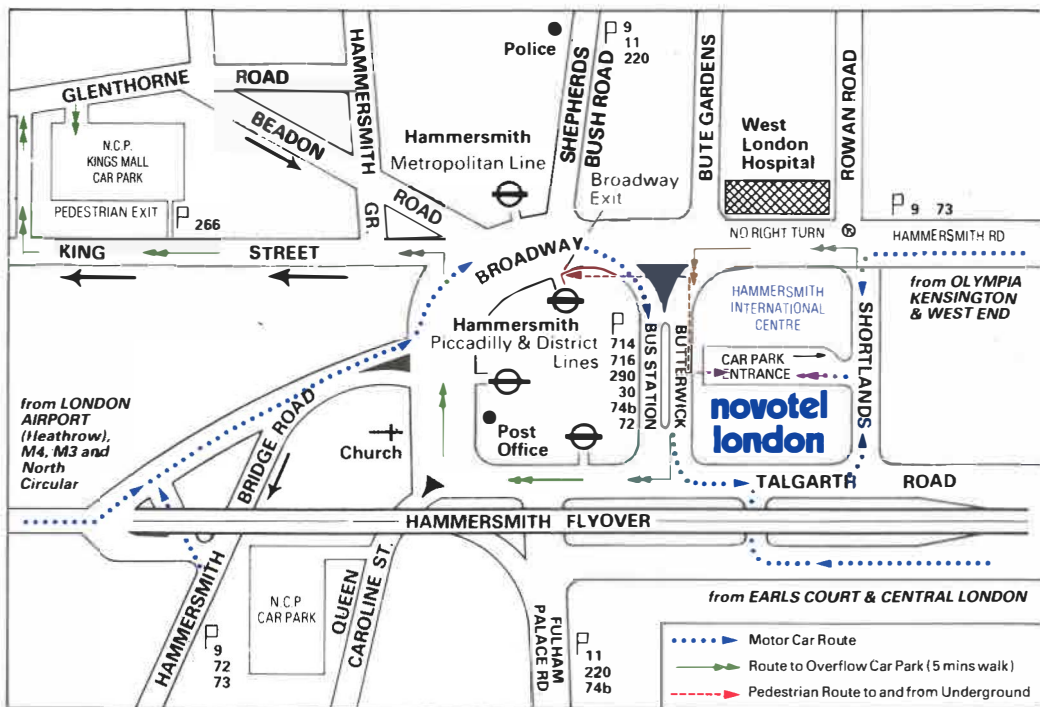
Must subscribe to the purposes of the Association, and be willing to accept committee assignments and other work to further its ends.

The officers who apply on behalf of a firm or corporation must be actively engaged in its business.

An **ASSOCIATE MEMBER** shall be affiliated with the lift, industry he shall not be actively engaged in the business of the manufacture installation repair or maintenance of lifts escalators and associated equipment.

An **HONORARY MEMBER** shall be one who has been an active representative of or member of the Association and has discontinued his commercial activities in the lift industry. An honorary member shall be permitted to attend meetings of the Association in a social capacity only. He shall not be permitted to vote nor be required to pay membership fees.

Only regular members shall be entitled to vote at the Association's meetings.
